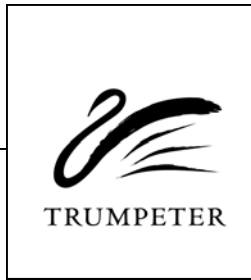

Susan Griffin is an award-winning poet, writer, essayist, playwright, and filmmaker, and has written nineteen books, including *A Chorus of Stones*, a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize and the National Book Award. Her works include *The Book of Courtesans*, *What Her Body Thought*, *Woman and Nature*, and she is the co-editor of the forthcoming *Transforming Terror*. A recipient of an Emmy, a MacArthur Grant for Peace and International Cooperation, and a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts, her writing has appeared in the *New York Times*, *Ms* magazine, and several other publications. She lives in Berkeley, California.

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
